The pain of COVID is continuing. Creative organizations and businesses lost 31% or more of their revenue in 2021, many creative workers have lost more than half of their income and these losses are continuing with Omicron cancellations and postponements in 2022.

## Illinois must be competitive.

Other states have taken action: Oregon, North Carolina, New York, and California, to name a few. New York passed a one-year budget giving their arts sector over \$200 million in dedicated funds, plus access to \$800 million in recovery grants. California legislators have enacted a \$600 million ARP package for their state's creative sector.

## It's time for Illinois to step up and directly support this state's creative sector.

Investment should prioritize Black, Indigenous, people of color, rural, and other disproportionately impacted communities.
